October 26th, I was blessed to attend the Grand Opening of this exhibition. Along with me was my friend who invited me to this Grand Opening that was held at The Queen’s Gallery.

At first, I thought the transportation can be a bit troublesome but in actuality, it was really simple. **You take MRT to Hua Lampong Station. You walk toward Exit 1 then hop on a taxi. Just that, the Queen’s Gallery is right around the corner (Ratchadamnoen Avenue with Bangkok Bank visibly located at the ground floor of the building.)**

The Queen’s Gallery, where the exhibition is being held, is the 5-storey building. From the Hall to the higher floors, you will get to enjoy the art pieces everywhere.

“171003” is exhibited on the 4th floor of the building. When you entered, you will be astounded by the art pieces completed with an amazing technique from Thai artist. One of the best things is, I get to know the name of the artists and their interesting biography.

The Grand Opening is indeed an eye-opening experience for me. This event invited so many Diplomats from many countries, the Artists themselves, Arts Collectors and many expats who love the arts just as much as I do.



All the great pieces were delivered from every corner of the world, most of them had never been presented in Thailand before. So, to satisfy the need of every art lovers who joined this exclusive event, an auction was hosted. And as you would expect, the bidding price is noteworthy. Basically, the bidding price starts at 50,000 THB and some pieces goes way higher. For instance; half a million baht.

Somehow, due to the difference in cultures and beliefs, each art pieces are unique from one another. When combined with the signature technique, even without the name of the artists, you would recognize the authenticity and the difference almost right away.

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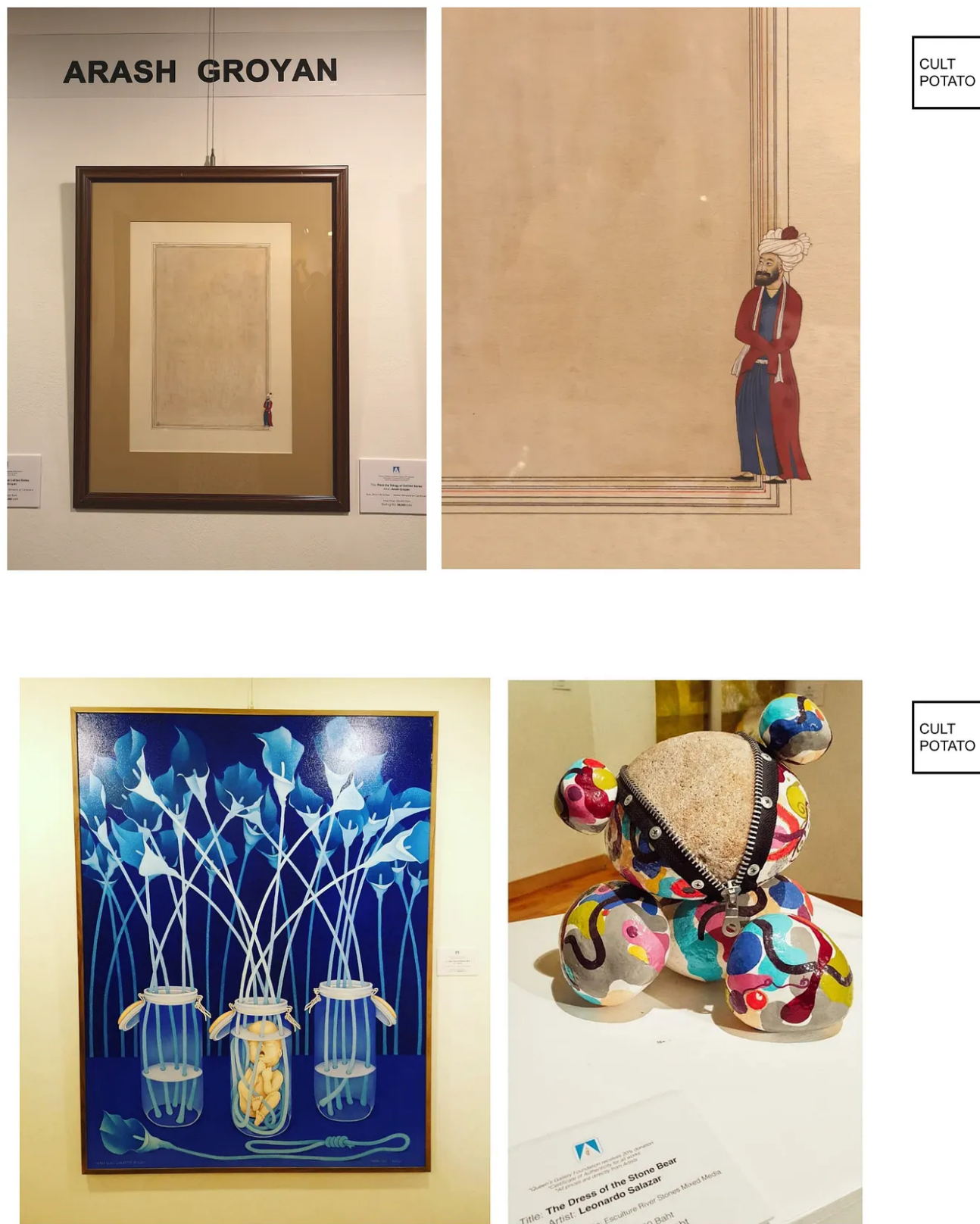
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Let’s check out some photos from the exhibition.
